At the NFRW Convention in Oklahoma City Kit Whitehill received the prestigious Ronald Reagan Leadership Award during the convention. The award was established by NFRW in 2005 to recognize the leadership of one state President every two years at the convention.

She is a resident of Coppell and has served as TFRW for the past two years. She was one of the five state presidents nominated. The qualifications for the nominees were based on overall leadership and initiation of new programs, increase in membership, participation in national programs, and excellence in public relations and campaign efforts.

The 40 Under 40 Fellowship to empower young women as future leaders was established under her leadership. During her presidency TFRW chartered 17 new clubs, reported over 3.3 million political activity hours totaling over \$100 million volunteer dollars and registered 167,000+ new Republican voters.
